RULES

CONTEST DETAILS

Goulbourn Museum is sponsoring this student art contest as part of a *War of 1812* awareness program. The finished art project – a full scale ‘head-in-hole’ painting – will be unveiled at the Museum’s *War of 1812 Tribute* on June 16, 2013 and kept onsite for public use.

PARTICIPATION

The contest is open to students enrolled in Grade 9 through Grade 12 who live in, or attend a school within, the former Goulbourn Township (Stittsville, Richmond, Ashton and Munster). This includes public, private and homeschooled students. Each student who meets the basic submission requirements will receive 10 hours towards their volunteer hours.

ARTWORK THEMES

Contest participants are asked to submit artwork on the following theme:

Soldiers of the War of 1812

The next page provides subject ideas to assist students as they prepare their contest entries.

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

Initial submission sketches:

- Artwork must be original and can be the work of one student or of teams to a maximum of five (5) students
- Submit on white 8 ½" X 11" paper
- Minimum one Union Jack flag
- Minimum one soldier
- Minimum two spots for heads, at different heights
- Include the words *War of 1812*

Final submission (to be completed by winner of initial submission only):

The winning artist(s) will be given the supplies to transform their sketch into a full scale ‘head-in-hole’ acrylic painting on high grade plywood measuring 5’W x 6’H. The artist(s) will leave blank areas for the faces and the Museum will create the holes. Deadline for finished painting is May 31, 2013.

SELECTION PROCESS

A panel of judges from the Goulbourn Museum will select one (1) winning submission. Winner(s) will be notified by **April 19, 2013**.

PRIZES/RECOGNITION

Upon completion of the final ‘head-in-hole’ project, the winning student(s) will receive 30 additional volunteer hours, a letter of reference, \$100 award (teams will only receive one monetary reward to be shared), coverage in the local newspaper and recognition in the Museum’s publications and social media. The winner(s) will also be a VIP at the official unveiling of the painting at the Museum’s *War of 1812 Tribute*.

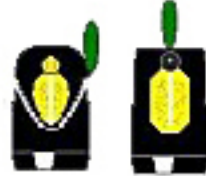
